

Dear Parent or Guardian,

The Williams Valley School District will begin Keystone Exams on May 17, 2021. Please help support your students by encouraging proper rest and preparation for these tests. The WVHS will test two section per day with the second day scheduled for make-ups. Students should come prepared, having a good breakfast, adequate rest, and a good mindset for the testing. Testing begins promptly at 7:50 am each morning.

Synchronous and Asynchronous students will test at the high school on campus in assigned testing rooms. Students should be dropped off no later than 7:40 am on testing days. Asynchronous and synchronous students will report to Guidance. After testing, students should have a ride available at 2:30 for pick-up.

Remote or online testing is not available for the Keystone exams.

The following schedule for the exams has been developed:

May 17 & 18th - Algebra
May 20 & 21st Biology
May 24 & 25th – Literature
May 27 & 28th – Additional
Makeup days

According to Act 158, students in the 2023 graduating class must demonstrate proficiency on all three tests to graduate. Please see the Keystone Pathways for more information on graduation requirements. The combination of a student's best score on Module 1 and Module 2 for any exam will be used to determine his/her overall score.
